### MCCLURE CELEBRATES 300<sup>th</sup> IN STYLE

Last week club legend Jimmy McClure has played his 300<sup>th</sup> game for the Armadale Cricket Club, and it was a resounding win in One Day D's. Jimmy had the honour of winning the toss, and he batted first, but wished he hadn't after he was out on the 1<sup>st</sup> ball of the innings, but a breezy 55 from son, Matt, got Armadale off to a flyer, and comfort at 2-88. A middle order collapse saw Armadale crumble to 7-115. A super fightback led by the ever reliable Pete Smith (51) and Ray Fowler (28) and a late cameo from skipper Joe Facey (15no) saw Armadale make a solid 206. Armadale got off to a flyer with the ball thanks to a superb spell from Tom Williams who snared 4-33 off his 8. And then it was over to Jim and Dan McClure who took the remaining 6 wickets. Dan took 3-21, while Jimmy took a superb 3-5 off 6 overs to celebrate his 300<sup>th</sup> in style, rolling Riverton for 91.

1<sup>st</sup> grade have had a good start to their season, batting first and making 273 against newcomers Willetton. After 2 early wickets Rhys Jones (74) and Jeff Petrie (52) set up things beautifully with superb knocks, but another collapse saw Armadale crumble to 9-223 with heaps of overs left despite Shane Neillings solid 26. Mark Bennett then teamed up with Rhett Jones to put on 50 runs for the last wicket in a vital partnership. Mark ended up with a fine 42no and Rhett a well made 17. Craig Ladhams then dominated the 2<sup>nd</sup> week, after things were even-going early on. Craig took two early wickets to see Willetton at 2-45, but Willetton got right on top at 3-167, and seemed to be coasting. A couple more wickets saw things even up at 5-171. Willetton then got back into it at 5-204. Enter Craig Ladhams. In devastating fashion, he and Dave Thomason (2-54) completely destroyed Willetton's lower order, snaring 5-3 between then to see them all out for 207. Craig ended up with magnificent figures of 6-48 off 20 overs. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> dig Dale ended up at 1/42.

3<sup>rd</sup> grade have had a disappointing loss in their clash against East Fremantle, who won the toss and batted. Armadale began brightly thanks to a fantastic spell by Raeborn D'Sylva (3-37), and Armadale had them on the ropes at 5-92, but after tea they got away and ended up scoring 8-266. Paul James and Matt Stockden both picked up a couple of wickets each for 50 runs. In reply Armadale were never really in the hunt. Carl Inness (26) and Michael Rowe (22) got starts, and some excellent batting from youngsters Rowan Mullane (44) and Chris Quayle (23) gave Armadale hope, but they ended up falling well short with 177. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> dig Matt Stockden snared 3-13 with East Freo making 4-45.

5<sup>th</sup> Grade have had an impressive win against Riverton, after batting first. Ryan Rawlings got off to a good start with a well made 47, and Neil Bartlett (26) and Alex Pass (21) chipped in, but Armadale were still in deep trouble at 7-104. Samuel Mullane started a great fightback with 18, and then Joel Stockden (33) and young Matt Thomason (23no) really batted well to allow Armadale post a competitive 185. In reply Riverton lost wickets at regular intervals all day and ended up being rolled for 136. New skipper Alex Pass led the way taking 5-42, while all the other bowlers chipped in with a good team effort. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> dig Armadale were 1-26.

7<sup>th</sup> Grade have had a solid win against Willetton in their opening one day game. Batting first Armadale got off to a flyer, despite 2 early wickets thanks to Shaun Portier (24), but from 2-59 they fell in a massive hole, falling to 7-86. But thanks to a great partnership between Marc Portier (31no) and Brian Fisher (24), Armadale were able to make a respectable 9-165. In reply Willetton were never in the hunt after a great opening spell by Brian Davey (3-16). They lost steady wickets to be dismissed for 128. Rohan D'Sylva bowled well to take 3-39 and Marc Portier claimed a fine double with 2-25.

One Day A's lost their 2<sup>nd</sup> game, going down to Riverton-Rostrata, who batted first and made 6-208. Ashley Starling was the pick of the bowlers with 4-37. After 3 early wickets, Owen Povah (26) and Ozzie D'Sylva (55) fought back well, and despite Mark Patterson's 37, Armadale fell well short with 147.

One Day B's have had a shocker against Leeming, who made 6-180 batting first. James Ogden was the best of the bowlers, with 2-22. In reply Armadale were rolled for a paltry 70, with Jeremy Turnbull top scoring with 14.

One Day D's are two from two after a solid win against Maddington. Batting first Armadale got off to a solid start thanks to Dan McClure (22) and Bert Facey (46), and the middle order was bolstered by a flying Rylan Arms (59), who was ably supported by youngster Dylan Clayton (20), enabling a solid 8-190. In reply, Maddington were on target at 2-61, but a devastating spell by the evergreen Jimmy McClure (3-13) turned the game Armadale's way. All the bowlers chipped in to see Maddington restricted to 8-149.

Armadale have just nominated an 8<sup>th</sup> side in a remarkable effort, and this team in One Day E's went down to Riverton Rostrata in an entertaining contest. Batting first Armadale were dismissed for 101 in only half their overs, with skipper Eric Pustkuchen making a whirlwind 48, including 3 sixes, and Jamie Davey made 21. In reply Armadale tried hard but didn't have the firepower, with Riverton making 7-195. Craig Igglesden bowled well to take 2-19, while Eric Pustkuchen took 2-28 to cap a good day.

### LAST WEEK

Armadale have gone down to Willetton in a low scoring One Day A's affair. Bowling first Armadale did well to dismiss Willetton for 114. Felix Machado led the way snaring 4 wickets, while Stephen Green took 3 and Paul Neretlis 2. In reply Armadale got off to a great start thanks to Dean D'Sylva (22), Paul Neretlis (23) and Oswin D'Sylva (20), but then completely fell in a hole to be dismissed for 88.

One Day B's had a great win against Southern River who batted first and were in deep trouble at 3-12, thanks to Jeremy Turnbull's fine opening spell (2-24), but fought back well to be 4-86. Enter Al Earp and James Ogden, Al ripped through the middle order to finish with 4-3, while James took 2-2 at the death to roll Southern River for 93. Armadale got off to a flyer thanks to Gary Edwards (29), but then lost 6-36 to be 6 for 68. James Ogden (14) began the fightback and Jeremy Turnbull (21) and Paul Edwards (23) saw Armadale home, to end up with 135.

## CLUB UNIFORMS

The club has a zero tolerance policy on wearing non club gear this year. All players are required to wear club CAPS and HATS ONLY. These will be on sale at the club. Captains are asked not to allow players to play in other styles and colours of shirts, caps and hats. Club caps and hats can be purchased for \$15 each.

## RESPONSIBILITIES of THE TEAM CAPTAIN

- Ensure that the ground and pitch are marked correctly and the ground report is completed prior to the commencement of play
- Coordinate the toss of the coin with the umpire and opposing team captain or if no umpire just the opposing team
- Provide the completed team list to the official umpire or opposing team captain if no umpire
- Pay the umpire his fee (\$100) prior to or at the tea break on the first day of a two day game when your team is the home team or prior to the tea break on the second day if you are the away team. Both captains must pay the umpire \$50 in the tea break for one day games
- In the event of a dispute between players step in to control the situation before it gets out of hand. Provide leadership to your team at all times
- If a situation develops where a player is upset by a decision that is given whether it be an official umpire or a club provided umpire it is the captain's responsibility to ensure that all players under his control show restraint. Failure to do so may result in the team captain being reported and penalised for his player's actions
- At the completion of each innings it is the captain's responsibility to check the score books and verify that they add up in all areas and are complete before signing off.
