FIRSTS LOSE THRILLER

Armada have gone down to Kardinya in a thriller in 1st grade, after winning the toss and batting. At 2-18 things looked really dicey, and when Shane Neillings and Matt McClure steadied things looked on the improved, but their dismissals put Armada under huge pressure at 4-57. An excellent partnership by Rhys Jones and Jeff Petrie (29, who was unlucky to be dismissed) too Armada to 4-111, but unfortunately it was all downhill after that. Rhys managed a superb 62, but with no one else managing a significant score Armada were bowled out for 166. After resuming at 1-45 overnight, Kardinya lost 2 early wickets to fall to 3-65. They recovered well however and were cruising at 3-121 when Dan McClure started an inspired spell, snaring 3-9 off 7 overs to turn the match completely, with the score at 6-130 at tea. Again Kardinya steadied at 6-150, but 2 marathon spells by Stacey Barrett (2-36 off 25) and Craig Ladhams (2-23 off 16) almost won Armada the match. Kardinya's last pair eked out the last 12 runs to win the game, eventually winning by 2 runs. In the 2nd dig Armada were 2-26.

3rd grade are on the board thanks to a resounding win against Willetton, who made 178 batting first. Stockden led the way with 3-44, while Paul James snared 3-46 and Raeborn D'Sylva 2-23. After starting at 1-34, Armada completely dominated the day, with opener Mark Ladhams making a fine 51, and nightwatchman Rhett Jones a superb 57. Michael Rowe (39) and Shawn Southam then continued to punish the attack, with Shawn the last man out for sublime 80, allowing a total of 303.

5th Grade won on a forfeit, but 7th Grade had a loss against Kelmscott, after making 234 batting first. Dave Armstrong got Armada off to a great start with 61, but no one else really got going despite 4 other blokes making double figures as Armada slumped to 7-151. Troy Anderson (54) then led from the front with a fine knock, with solid support from Marc Portier (23no) before Marc and Brian Davey (16) put on 27 for the last wicket. Kelmscott ended up just passing the score, finishing at 9-265. The bowlers toiled well all day, with Brian Davey finished with 3-59, Brian Fisher 2-29 and Rohan D'Sylva 2-47.

One Day A's have won an amazing game of cricket against Kelmscott. Armada batted first and got off to a solid start at 0-18 thanks to Seas D'Souza's 15, but then a massive collapse saw Armada crumble to 6-51. Paul Neretlis hit back with a brief 18, and at 6-82 seemed to be getting some momentum, but again collapsed to be all out for 92. In reply Kelmscott were 2-2, but steadied to be comfortable at 2-36, and 3-50. But Sean D'Souza (4-15), Steve Green (2-6) and Paul Neretlis (2-21) bowled beautifully to stun Kelmscott and rolled them for 75 in a memorable performance.

One-Day B's won on a forfeit, and One Day D's had another fantastic win, this time against Cockburn, who batted first and made 7-155. Jeremy Turnbull bowled a superb spell (2-9 off 8), and Warren Francis snared 2-16. In reply Armada got a good start thanks to Jimmy McClure (18) and Joe Facey (16), then Adam Facey (15) supported Rylan Arms well as Rylan teed off, making a sensational 83 not out to steer Armada home to 6-178 for a fine win.

One Day E's have gone down fighting against Cockburn, who made 142 batting first. Brad Miles was the star with the ball, taking 5-34, while Craig Igglesden took 2-16. In reply Armada had a crack, thanks to Josh Whalan (30) and Troy Higgins (19) but fell short, being all out for 103.

LAST WEEK

One Day A's are finally off the mark, scoring a resounding victory against Cockburn. Batting first Armada got off to a solid start, with Mark Patterson making 32, and meandered along to 5-141, before Oswin D'Sylva (83) and Neil Bartlett (66) smashed them everywhere in a great partnership, enabling a massive 7-264. In reply Cockburn slumped to 4-31, but recovered to 4-134, and then collapsed completely to be rolled for 154. Sean D'Souza led from the front with 3-23 and Dean D'Sylva snared 2-19.

One Day B's are also back in the winners list after beating Hilton. Hilton batted first and made 9-151, with one guy making 102 not out in a fine solo effort. Armada worked well as a bowling unit with Paul Edwards (2-15), Al Earp (2-13) and Nathan Kitney (2-21) all doing well. In reply Armada got off to a good start thanks to Paul (26) and Gary (27) Edwards, but then lost steady wickets to be in some trouble. But thanks to Owen Povah's 51 Armada passed the score 6 down, before last pair Darcy Trainor (18no) and Al Earp (31no) rubbed it in enabling total of 9-220.

One Day D's have had a cracking win against Kardinya, who made 156 batting first. At 3-100 Kardinya looked right on top but thanks to Darren Watt (2-18), Joe Facey (2-15) and Pete Smith (3-23) Armada ran through the tail quickly. In reply Armada were in all sorts of trouble at 4-36, despite Darren Watt's 21 on debut. Alex Cumming (41) and Pete Smith (47) then turned the game with a great partnership of 95. Armada however still required 17 runs with 2 wickets in hand and overs running out. Skipper Joe Facey (17no) and Glen Cumming (9no) got Armada home in a thriller, Armada finishing on 8-168.

One Day E's have gone down to Willetton after only making 89 batting first. Paul Harvey made a solid 27, and Eric Pustkuchen 15. In reply Willetton cruised home, making 8-184. Brad Miles made a welcome return to the club, taking 3-27, while the rest were sharded around.
