### ROHAN D'SYLVA DESTROYS MADDINGTON

Armada have had a devastating outright loss to reigning premiers Leeming in the 1<sup>st</sup> Gde grand final replay. Batting first we were in deep trouble at 4-22, before Craig Ladhams (34) and Shane Neillings (18) fought back well. Unfortunately the tail completely collapsed to be all out for 95. We fought back with the ball to have them 2-13 and 3-41 before Leeming got right on top. At 3-170 overnight, Leeming went on to smash 8-248 decl. Rhys Jones bowled superbly with 3-24, while Stacey Barrett (2-25) and Davey Thomason (2-52) also bowled well. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> dig, Armadale were rolled for 110. Michael Brown made a solid 23 and Rhys Jones 26 but again the tail collapsed in a disappointing finish.

3<sup>rd</sup> Grade have also had a loss against Leeming after Leeming made 321 batting first. Leeming were pretty much in control all day, and took full advantage of a tiring attack late in the day. Raeburn D'Sylva bowled with venom and deserved his 3-39, while Matt Stockden toiled well for 2 wickets. Armadale got off to a flyer thanks to Matt Williams (26) and had a solid platform thanks to Matt McClure (32), while skipper Shawn Southam made a sublime 50. Armadale were in a solid position and on target run rate wise, but kept losing wickets and were dismissed for 196. Mark Ladhams posted a handy 23 towards the end in an encouraging effort.

5<sup>th</sup> Grade have had a solid win against Hilton, after making 234 batting first. In an amazing team effort, no one posted over 34, while 9 guys made double figures. Rowan Mullane led the way with 34, while Neil Bartlett (27), Stephen Tooth (28) and Matt Thomason (23) all contributed well. At 8-182, Armadale could have been bowled out for well under 200, but Joel Stockden (34) and Ainsley Noronha (22) had a great partnership to really press home the advantage. In reply, in a brilliant team bowling effort Hilton were dismissed for 162. Skipper Alex Pass and Dean Yetton led the way with 3-37 each, while Ryan Davey and Ainsley Noronha both snared 2-40. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> dig Armadale were 2-22.

7<sup>th</sup> grade have really dominated their clash with Maddington. Batting first Armadale made 176 after Rylan Arms got off to a flyer (34), but then fell in a massive hole, falling to 5-57. Once again Pete Smith pulled Armadale out of the crap scoring a super 58, including 12 boundaries (who needs to run?). Pete had Rohan D'Sylva (14), Warren Francis and Marc Portier as the perfect foils while as they hung around. Then Ash Smith (11) and Brian Davey (12) chipped in at the end to allow score of 176. In reply we had Maddington on the back foot thanks to a great start by Brian Davey (3-28) and Troy Anderson (2-10), but then Rohan D'Sylva had the spell of his life, bowling 5 overs, taking 5-2 in an incredible effort seeing Maddo rolled for a paltry 40. One Day A's bad start to the season got worse, with a defeat to Leeming. Batting first Armadale made a solid 199. Oswin D'Sylva made a superb 79, while Ashley Starling a handy 33. In reply though Leeming got 6-264. At 6-182 Armadale had a sniff thanks to Sean D'Souza's 2 quick wickets, but Armadale were not able to keep the pressure on long enough.

One Day B's form with the bat continues to cost them games, this time against Southern Districts, who made 159 batting first. Nathan Kitney continued his good form with the ball taking 3-9, while David Pearson took 3-10 and Darcy Trainor 2-42. In reply Armadale were 1-22 after Paul Edwards made 15, but then collapsed completely to be 7-33. Jez Turnbull (19) and Al Earp (15no) had a crack but there was too much work to do as Armadale were rolled for 77.

One Day D's have suffered their 1<sup>st</sup> loss of the season, against SJ Blues. Batting first Armadale were in deep trouble at 4-31, but a magnificent 69 from Bert Facey, who was supported well by Alex Hickling (10) enabling a score of 9-123. In the field Armadale tried hard but couldn't quite peg SJ's back enough and they finished up with 4-161. Tom Williams was his usual self taking 1-23 off his 8, while Sam Mullane, Dylan Clayton and Bert Facey all chipped in with a wicket.

One Day E's have gone down to Phoenix after making only 104 batting first. Craig Igglesden got Armadale off to a good start with 19 before skipper Eric Pustkuchen again top scored with a belligerent 46. In reply, 3 quick wickets gave Armadale a sniff thanks to Josh Whalan (3-16 off 8), but in the end Phoenix cruised home to finish with 6-183
