ARMADALE CRUSH COCKBURN

Armadale's 1st Grade have bounced back in style, crushing Cockburn in their clash at Gwynne Park. Batting first Cockburn were in early trouble at 2-14, but steadied to be 3-66. Davey Thomason then started an inspired spell, snaring 4 for 30. Craig Ladhams (2-31) and Stacey Barrett (2 for 9 off 8 overs) continued their good form with the ball, seeing Cockburn routed for just 99, losing their last 7 wickets for 33. In reply however, Armadale crumbled to 5-53, and eventually crawled to 5-64 overnight, setting up a battle for the win. On the 2nd week the overnight batsmen, Jeff Petrie (29) and Stacey Barrett (28) saw Armadale home, before Michael Rowe (42no), Craig Ladhams (27) and Matt Williams (27no) punished the attack, allowing Armadale to declare at 9-203. In the 2nd dig Cockburn started well (0-40 and later 2-84), before Rhys Jones (2-22) and Mark Bennett (2-21) triggered a collapse to 7-114, before Cockburn steadied to 7-139 to avoid the outright loss.

3rds have won a hard fought contest against Kelmscott after batting first and making 5-234. Shane Saxon (24) started off well with Mark Ladhams who continued his good form making an impressive 48. Rhett Jones then again chipped in with 29, before a few wickets saw Armadale stumble at 4-131. But skipper Shawn Southam steadied the ship with a solid 40no, while Paul James dominated the final overs with a fine 55. In reply Kelmscott put up a good fight but Armadale took wickets at regular intervals to peg Kelmscott back. At 4-159 and 5-193, the game was in the balance, but in the end Armadale maintained their composure to restrict Kelmscott to 8-226. Rhett Jones was the leading wicket taker with 3-50, while all the other bowlers did their bit in a brilliant team effort.

5th grade have lost their 1st game of the year after a shocker against SJ. Batting first, Armadale were all out for 75, with Dean Yetton the only bat to get over 10. In reply Armadale fought well, restricting SJ to 8-137. Matt Thomason (2-12), Rylan Arms (2-21) and Dean Yetton (2-21) all bowled well.

7th Grade have demolished Canning Districts after batting first and making 7-206. All the bats chipped in, but it was opener Warren Francis (35), Jacob Baird (32) and Pete Smith (28) who led the way, before Ash Smith Smashed a quick fire 32no at the end. But skipper Joe Facey turned back the clock with a superb 50no and with the help of a few cameos got the score up to 7-149. In reply SJ were never really troubled and cruised to 7-193. 
